1 My windows and doors are leaking water!

There is no motivation like desperation. Once you see water damage in your home, you know the leak has probably been going on for a while. A little water goes a long way when it comes to damaging a home. If action isn't taken quickly, you may end up spending money that could have been used to upgrade your windows and doors, on a costly home repair. At best, you may get back to where you were before the damage, not adding any value or comfort to your home.

2 My windows and doors are drafty!

Air infiltration is also a major problem, especially in climates such as Texas. Feeling drafts inside your home when the windows are closed is a serious issue, because you know if air is coming in through your windows, money is going out!

3 My windows and doors are fogging up!

When you can't see through a window or door, you know that there is a definite problem. It is also an embarrassing blemish on your home. If you can't see through your windows and doors, they may as well be walls. At least they will insulate you better than a builder grade window.

Forty years ago, energy bills were not what they are today. Twenty years from today, who knows what they are going to be? Historically, energy bills have risen around 6%-8% annually. The Department of Energy and the American Society of Heating, Refrigeration, and Air Conditioning Engineers have done some in-depth studies on how much of your utility bill is directly related to your windows and doors. Let me tell you, it is a significant number. Companies claim they can save you on energy costs. Although the numbers vary, they all agree that new windows and doors will lower your bill.

5 My home is not comfortable and has hot and cold rooms!

You really have to live in a home before you learn about the condition of its windows. It is impossible to tell at a glance exactly how bad the heat and cold penetration really may be. Many times looks are deceiving. Things like, where the sun rises and sets, how much shade you have, and how your roof or porch is constructed all have to do with the amount of direct sun exposure each rooms get. In Texas, keeping the heat out of your home is a real issue for about 6-8 months of the year. In case you haven't noticed yet, builder-grade products don't do a very good job of that. 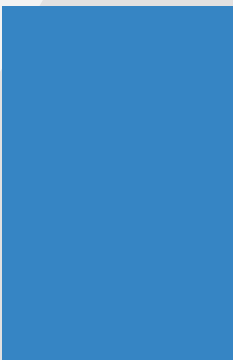
